The National Park Service at Chamizal National Memorial is offering the **Teacher Corp Internship (TCI)** program for the 2016 summer (6-8 weeks; schedule is flexible). TCI program is a professional development program through the University of Colorado for teachers working in the National Parks. Teachers selected for the program will receive a stipend of \$2400 after completion of all course work through UC and park work projects.



Chamizal National Memorial TCI will assist with the July Trailblazer/ Find Your Park program that gives local children the opportunity to visit regional national parks. TCI will also sort, organize, and write lesson plans for elementary, middle, and high school students focusing on the stories of Chamizal National Memorial. Teachers in this TCI position will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of ranger duties.
